

Open Access Statement

The Journal „INTELLECTUS” is an electronic publication with Open Access, subject to a double review process, with free online access. According to the open access definition of the Budapest Open Access Initiative, users have the right to „read, download, copy, distribute, print, or link” to the full texts of the articles.

„Open Access” allows collegially evaluated research literature to be freely available on the public internet, permitting any users to read, download, copy, distribute, print, search, or link to the full texts of these articles, crawl them for indexing, pass them as data to software, or use them for any other lawful purpose, without financial, legal, or technical barriers other than those inseparable from gaining access to the internet itself. The only constraint on reproduction and distribution, and the only role for copyright in this domain, should be to give authors control over the integrity of their work and the right to be properly acknowledged and cited.

Open Access to the results of scientific research is supported in particular by the Budapest Open Access Initiative (BOAI), by the Berlin and Bethesda initiatives. In our country, the state policy in the field of science and innovation is based on the Code on Science and Innovation of the Republic of Moldova, adopted in 2004, which provides for the guarantee of access to scientific information.

AGEPI, as founder and publisher, and CNAA, as co-publisher of the publication, support the Open Access Policy and undertake to provide access to the Journal „INTELLECTUS”, which is a scientific publication with Open Access.
