The Director General of the State Agency on Intellectual Property (AGEPI), Eugeniu Rusu, participated in the period September 21-22, 2023, in the international Congress with the main title *"Protection of Intellectual Property - Future Challenges and Trends"* held in Warsaw, Poland. This event was organized as part of the celebrations of the 105th anniversary of the establishment of the Polish Patent Office and the Polish industrial property system.
