Inventor's and Rationalizer's Day is annually marked on the last Saturday of June in the Republic of Moldova.

A festive meeting, organized by the Union of Inventors and Rationalizers of Moldova "Innovator" (UIR) and the State Agency on Intellectual Property (AGEPI) was held on 28 June this year on this occasion. The host of the event was the National Confederation of Trade Unions of Moldova (NCTUM).

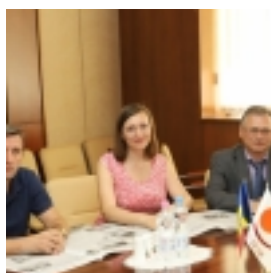
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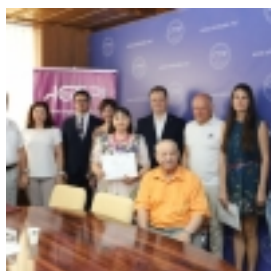
