The 13th edition of the European Exhibition of Innovation and Creativity EUROINVENT-2021 is held online from 20 to 22 May, in Iași, Romania.

The opening ceremony was attended by inventors, researchers, students and doctoral students from over 30 countries around the world, including Canada, the Czech Republic, Croatia, Poland, Morocco, Thailand, Vietnam, etc. The Republic of Moldova is present at the event with an imposing delegation representing the most important research institutions of the country, including the State University of Moldova, Technical University of Moldova, State University of Pharmacy and Medicine “Nicolae Testemitanu”, Institute of Chemistry, Institute of Microbiology and Biotechnology, Institute of Physiology and Sanocreatology, Academy of Economic Studies of Moldova, etc.

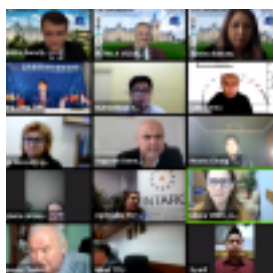
During the ceremony, with a welcoming speech for the participants came Liliana Vieru, Head of the Communication and International Relations Department of the State Agency on Intellectual Property (AGEPI) who congratulated the organizers on the performance of organizing an event of such magnitude during the pandemic. “Over the years, AGEPI and the organizers of the Exhibition EUROINVENT managed to establish close cooperation relations, becoming already a tradition the mutual participation of representatives from Romania and the Republic of Moldova in the International Specialized Exhibition INFOINVENT, organized by AGEPI and the Exhibition EUROINVENT, organized by the Romanian Inventors Forum. Over 650 inventions and projects from 32 participating countries are exhibited at the Exhibition EUROINVENT-2021. These will be evaluated by an International Jury, and the Award Presentation Ceremony will take place on Saturday, May 22, 2021, also in online format.

The exhibition program also includes the ICIR EUROINVENT International Conference. During the conference, researchers, engineers and top scientists address real research issues in the field of materials science and engineering. The 7th edition of ICIR EUROINVENT takes place in the period May 20-21, 2021. The National Salon of Scientific-Technical and Artistic Book takes also place within the framework of the exhibition. The Jury will evaluate and award the most valuable books and magazines.

The event is organized by the Romanian Inventors Forum, in partnership with the Gh. Asachi Technical University, Al. I. Cuza University and EUROPE DIRECT Iași. EUROINVENT is the only event in Romania held under the aegis of the International Federation of Inventors' Associations IFIA and WIIPA Taiwan, being the largest event dedicated to inventions in Eastern Europe.
