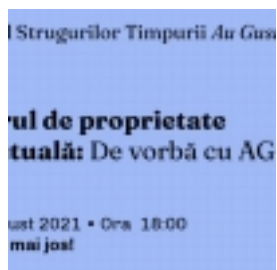
The workshop will be aimed at all beginners who want to start a business, especially young craftsmen, farmers, traders and more.
