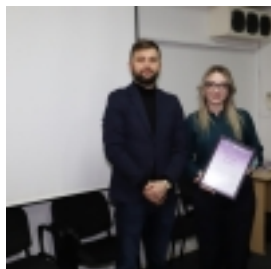
During the debate, students had the opportunity to connect to an interactive environment and ask questions to AGEPI specialists.

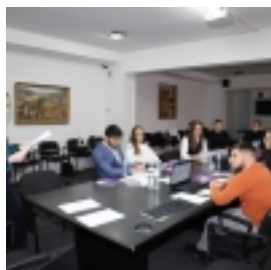

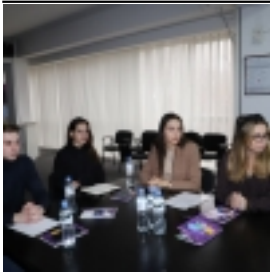
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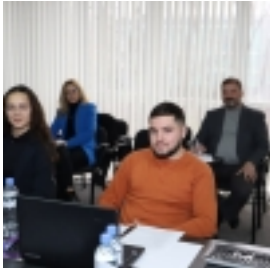
