On April 17, 2025, the State Agency on Intellectual Property (AGEPI) and the Institute for Standardization of Moldova (ISM) signed a Cooperation Agreement, aimed at strengthening inter-institutional cooperation in support of small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) and the business environment of the Republic of Moldova.

The agreement was signed by Eugeniu Rusu, Director General of AGEPI, and Andrian Bunduc, Acting Director of ISM.
