

Validation of European Patents in the Republic of Moldova

An agreement between the European Patent Organisation and the Republic of Moldova allowing European patents to take legal effect in the Republic of Moldova (Validation Agreement) entered into force on **1 November 2015**.

Key elements of the validation system

Validation for the Republic of Moldova is deemed requested for any European or international application filed with the European Patent Office (EPO) on or after 1 November 2015.

Validation fee


Validation fee for the Republic of Moldova is **EUR 200**. It must be paid to the EPO within six months of the date on which the European Patent Bulletin mentions the publication of the European search report, or, where applicable, within the period for performing the acts required for an international application's entry into the European phase.

Validation of the granted European patent

After payment of the validation fee and within three months of the date on which the mention of the grant of the European patent has been published, the proprietor of the patent shall provide the **State Agency on Intellectual Property (AGEPI)** with a translation of the specification in the Romanian language and pay the prescribed fee for publication.

Applicable law

Validated European patent applications and patents are governed by the Republic of Moldova Law No. 50-XVI of 7 March 2008 on the Protection of Inventions as amended by Law 160 of 30.07.2015.
